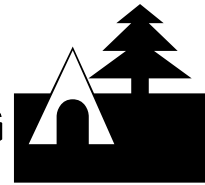

Camp Tips:

- Using briquettes, remember that each briquette will provide 40° F or 4.5° C. When used, space the briquettes evenly, rather than a tight pile. This will make it easier to obtain an even temperature for cooking.**
- Ropes with cotton content will stretch when wet, but shrink when dry. Keep this in mind at your fall camps.**
